## RoHS2 Statement of Non-Use of Restricted Substances 2018

Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union (RoHS2 Directive) restricts the use of the certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment's and came into force on January 1, 2013.

The products affected by this Directive, if placed on the market after January 1, 2013, must non contain more than the permitted limit values of any of the following hazardous substances:

- 0,1 % (by weight of homogeneous material) mercury (Hg), lead (Pb), hexavalent chromium (CR VI), polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) and
- 0,01% (by weight of homogeneous material) cadmium (Cd)
